ACS Secretary General meets with T&T Meteorological Services



Port of Spain (April 13, 2010) – The Secretary General of the Association of Caribbean States (ACS), Ambassador Luis Fernando Andrade Falla met with Mr. Emmanuel Moolchan, Director, Trinidad & Tobago Meteorological Services on 8 April at the Association's Headquarters in Port of Spain.

This meeting was organised within the context of the proposed cooperation between the ACS and the Government of Finland through the Finnish Institute of Meteorology, who is offering the regional support that can facilitate the strengthening of systems and meteorological capabilities of Trinidad and Tobago.
